

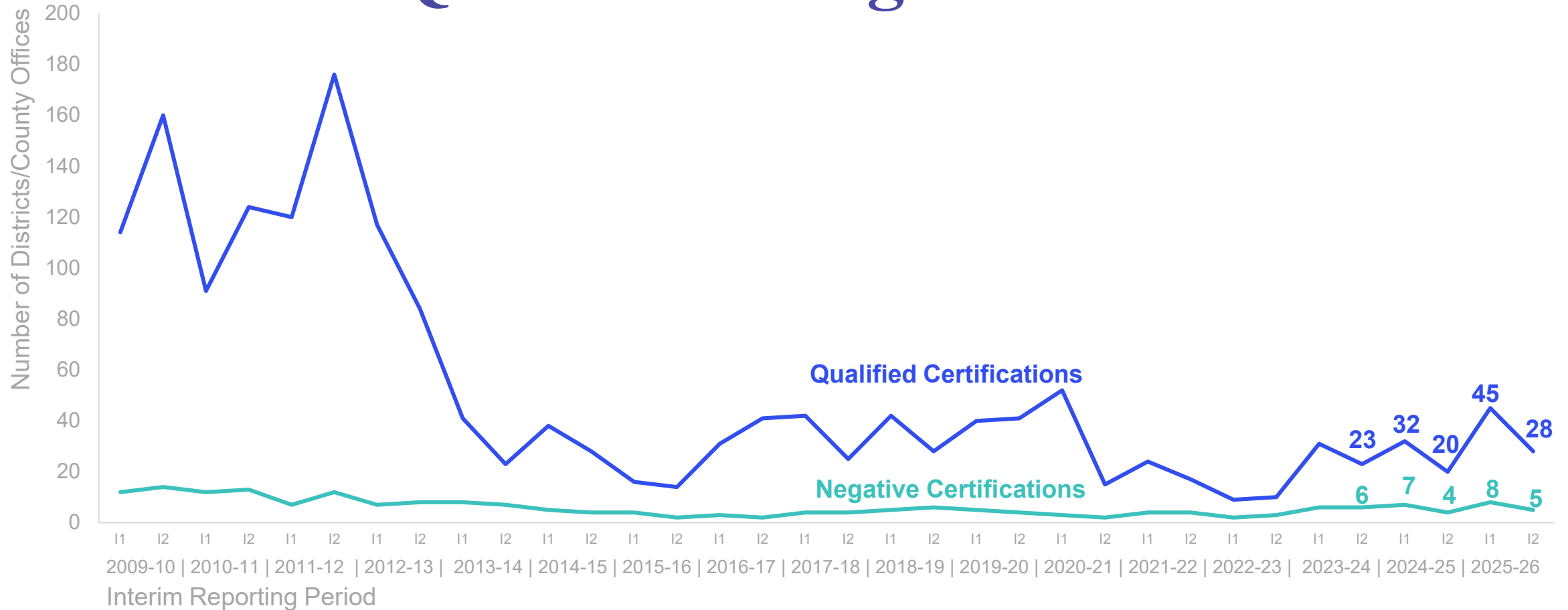

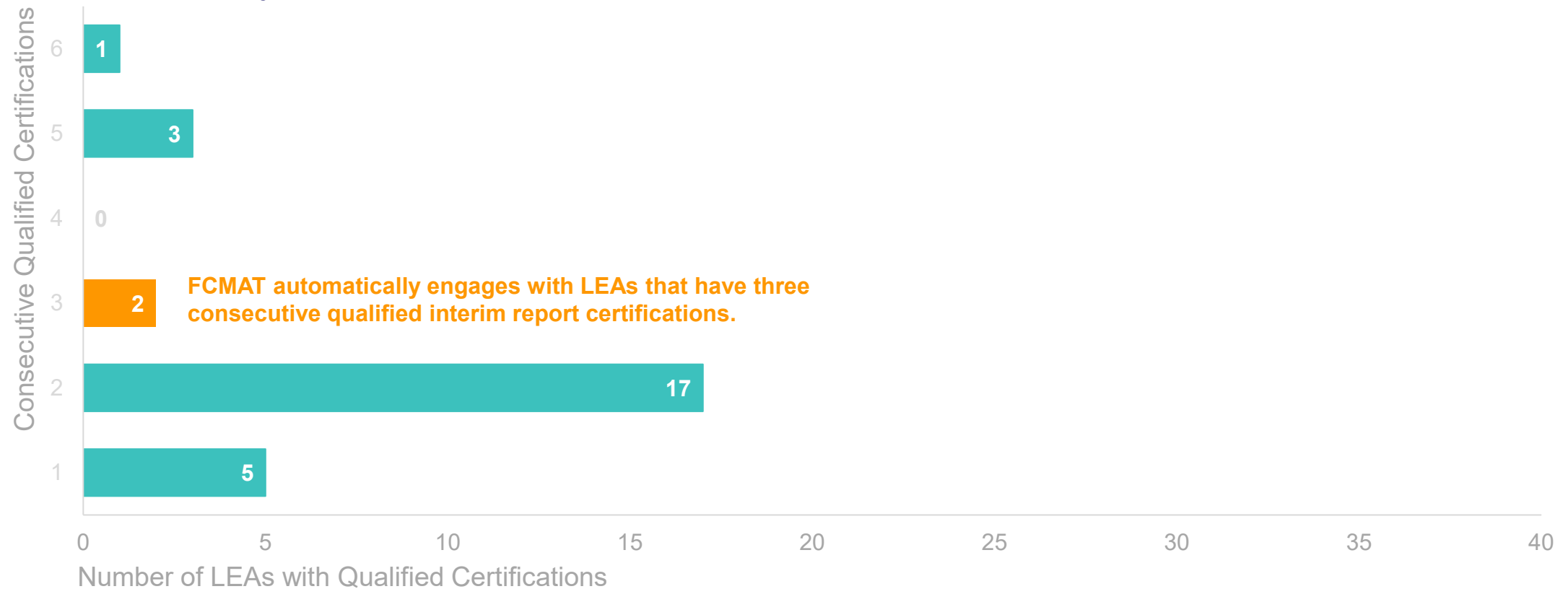
Historical Qualified & Negative Certifications

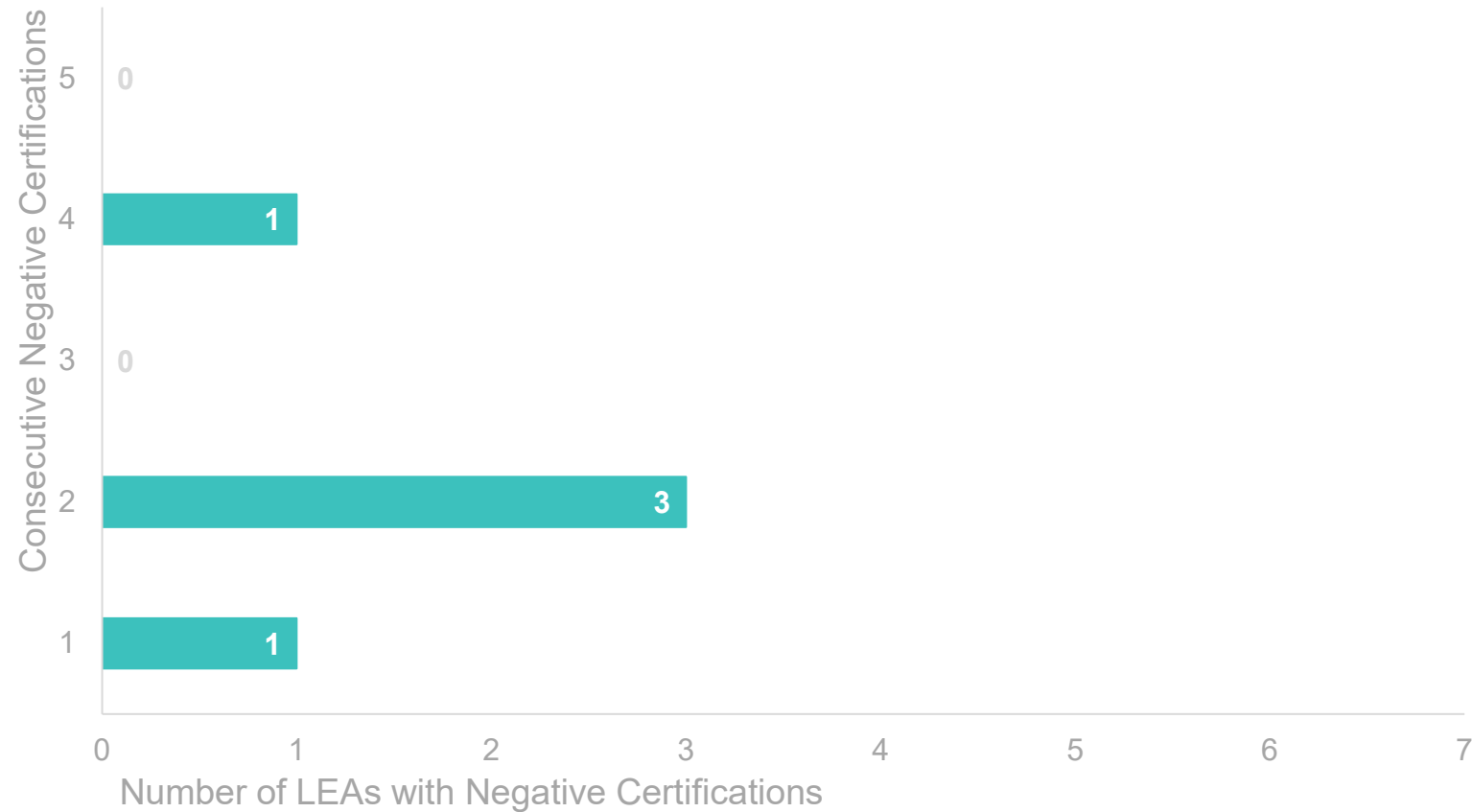

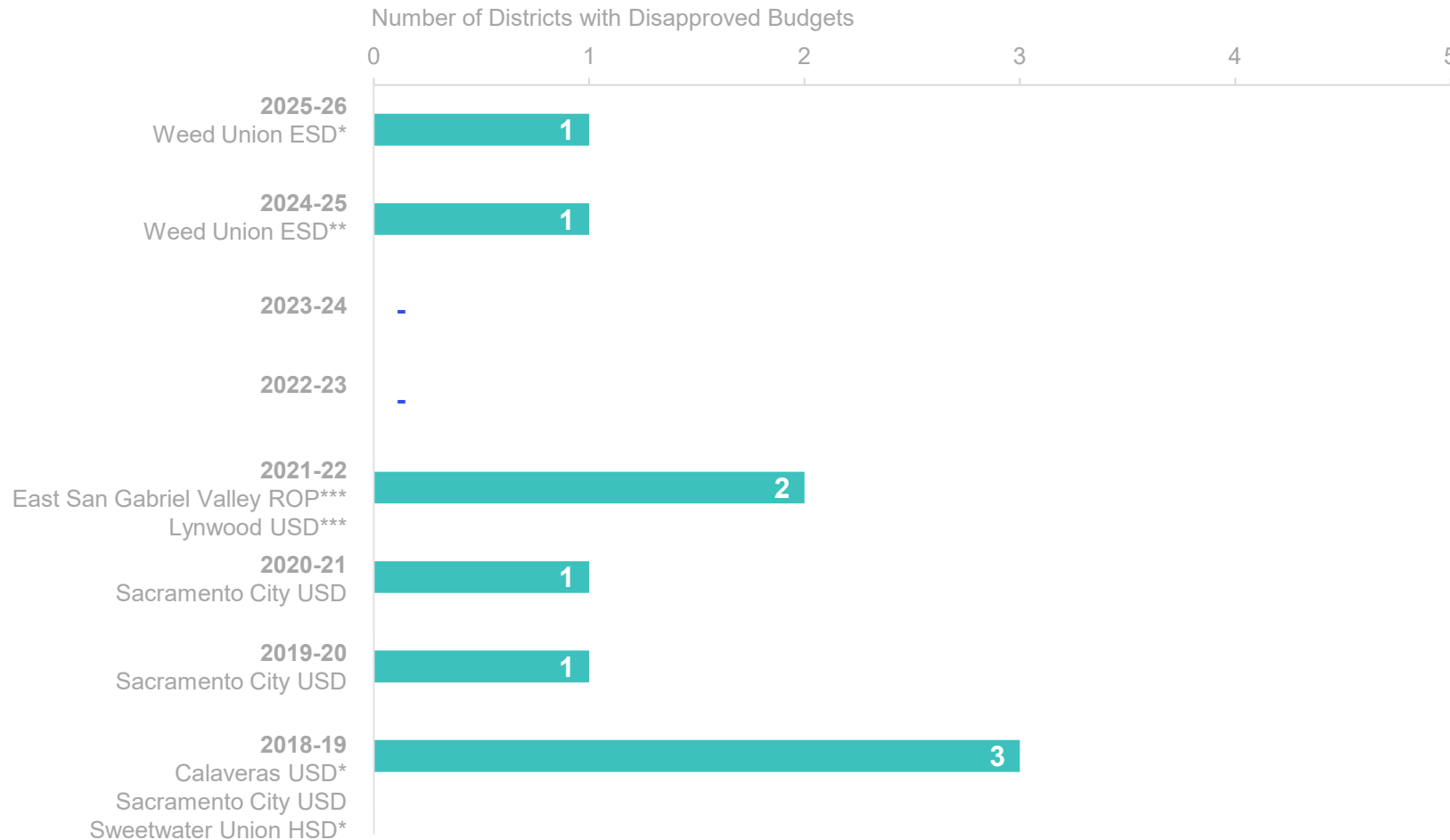

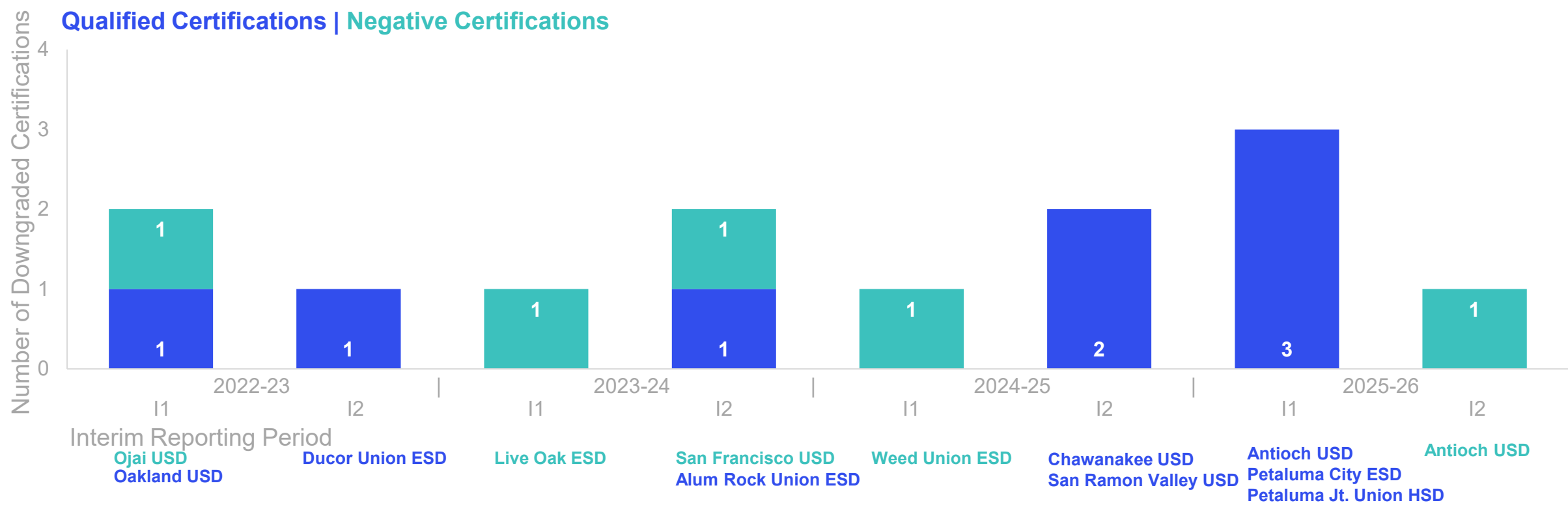

Downgraded Interim Report Certifications

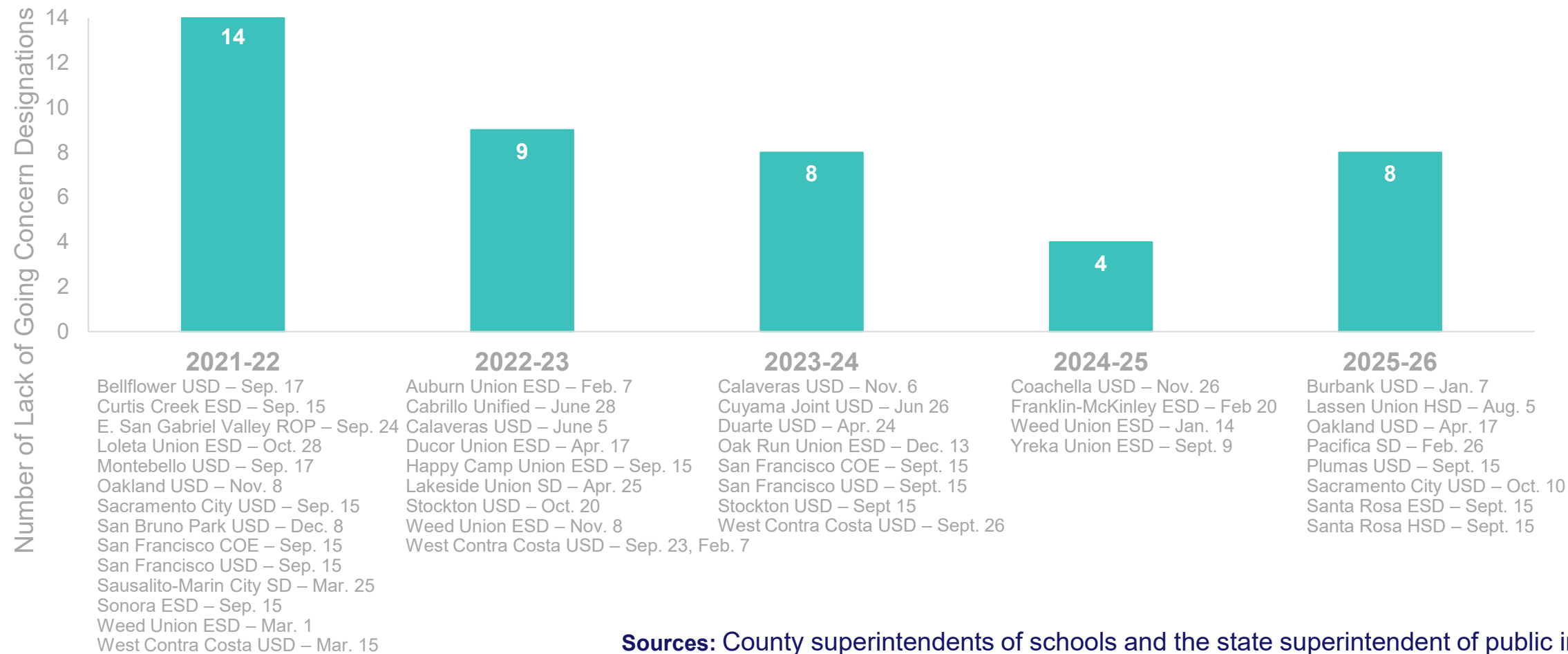

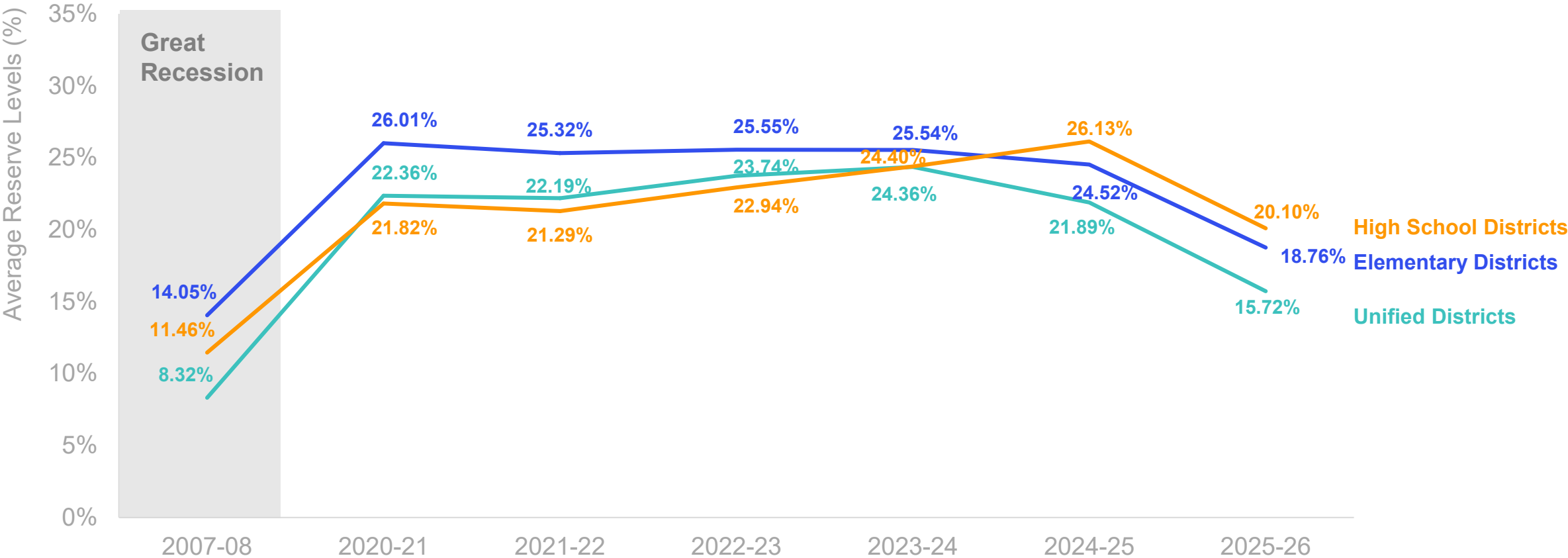
Lack of Going Concern Designations
