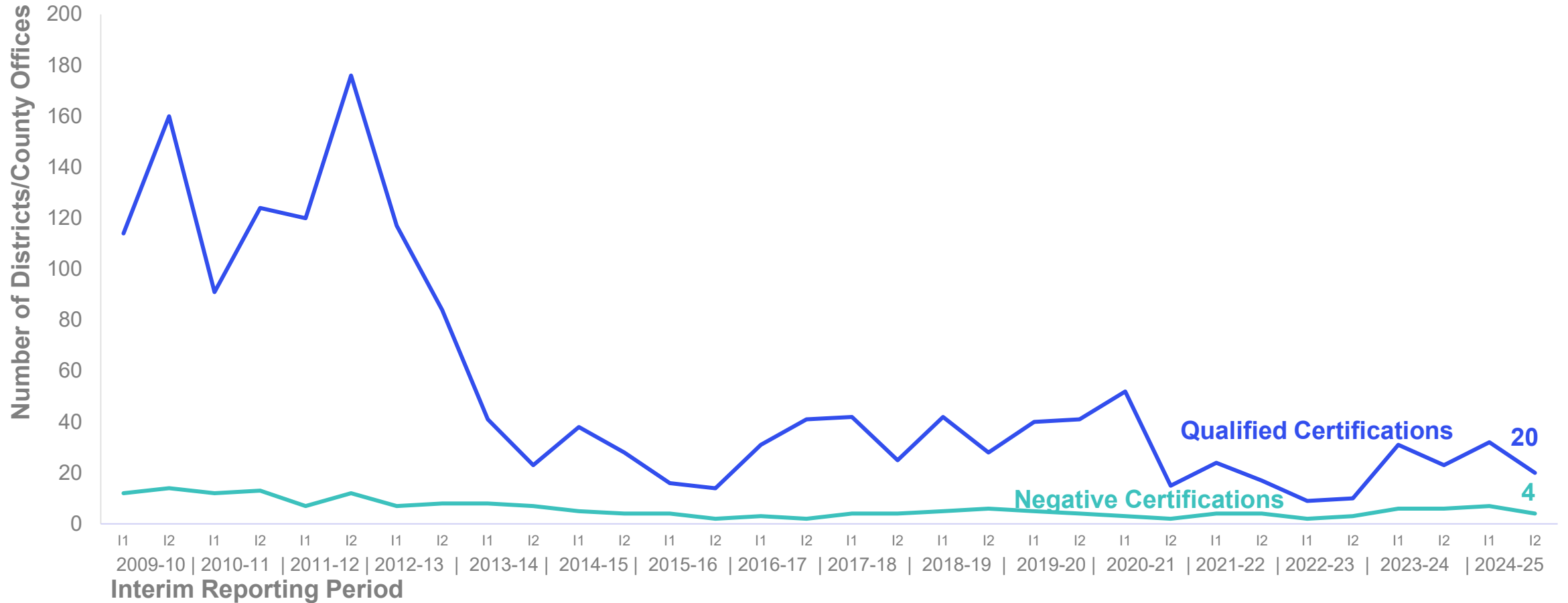

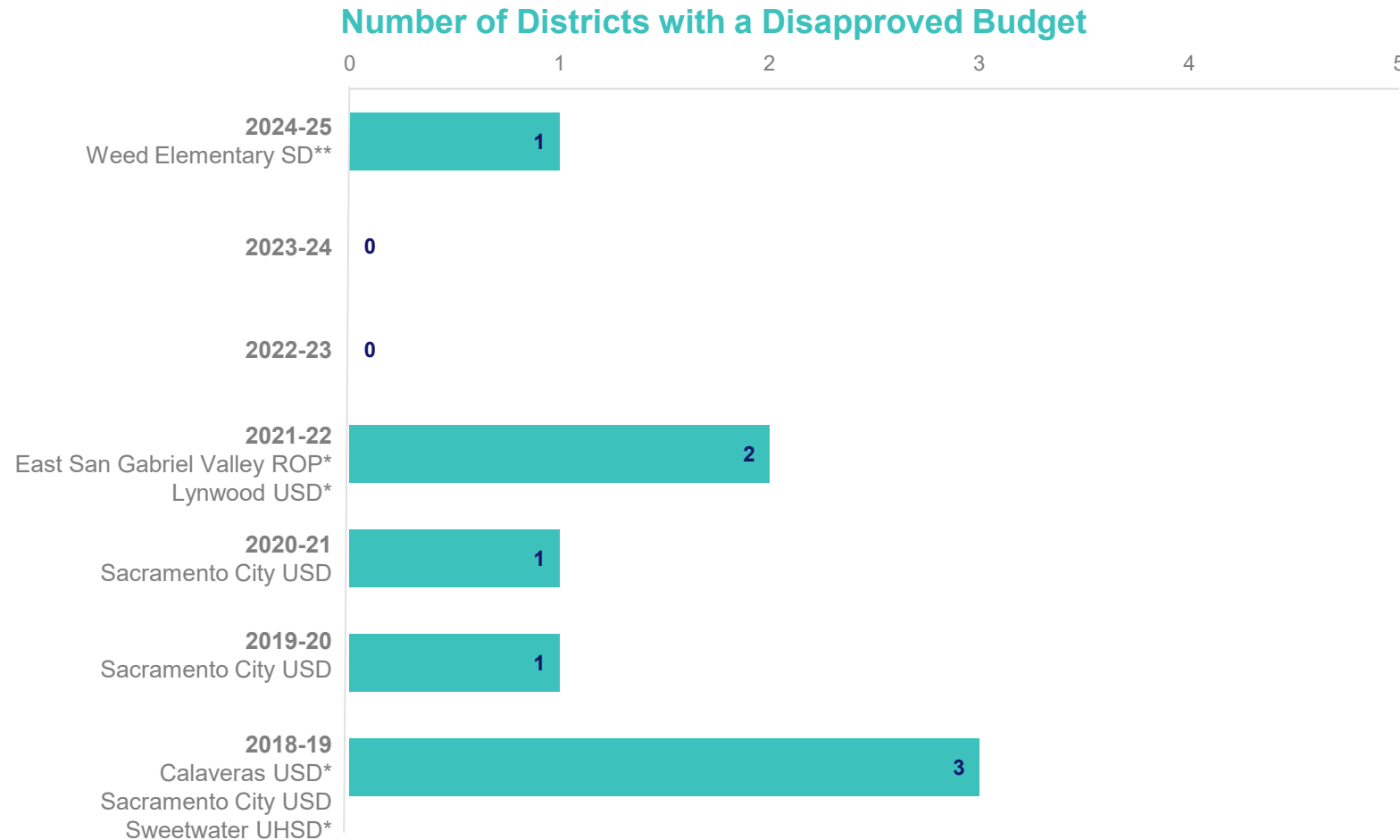
Historical Qualified & Negative Certifications

Note: Chart excludes disapprovals solely due to unapproved Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP).

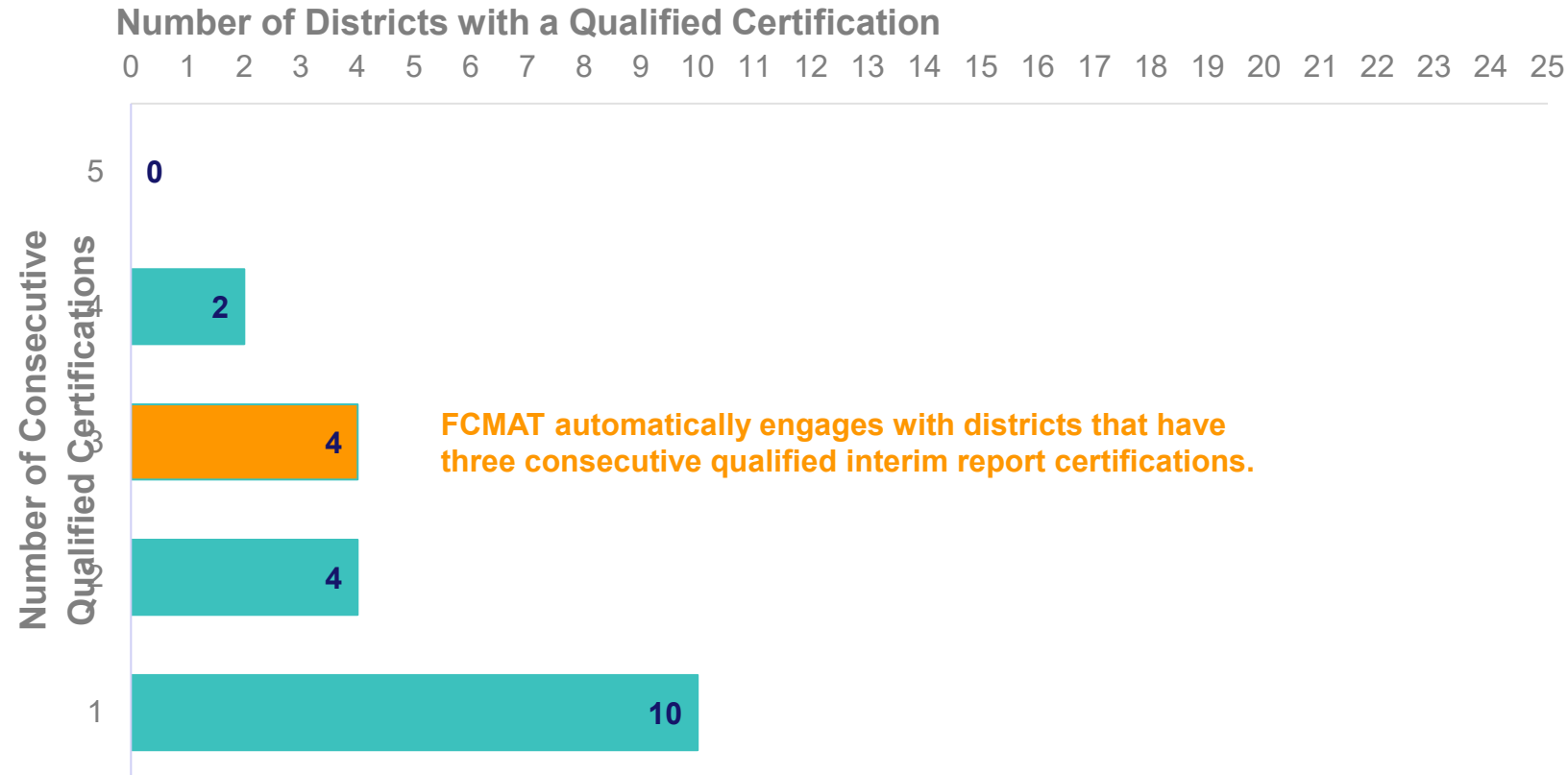

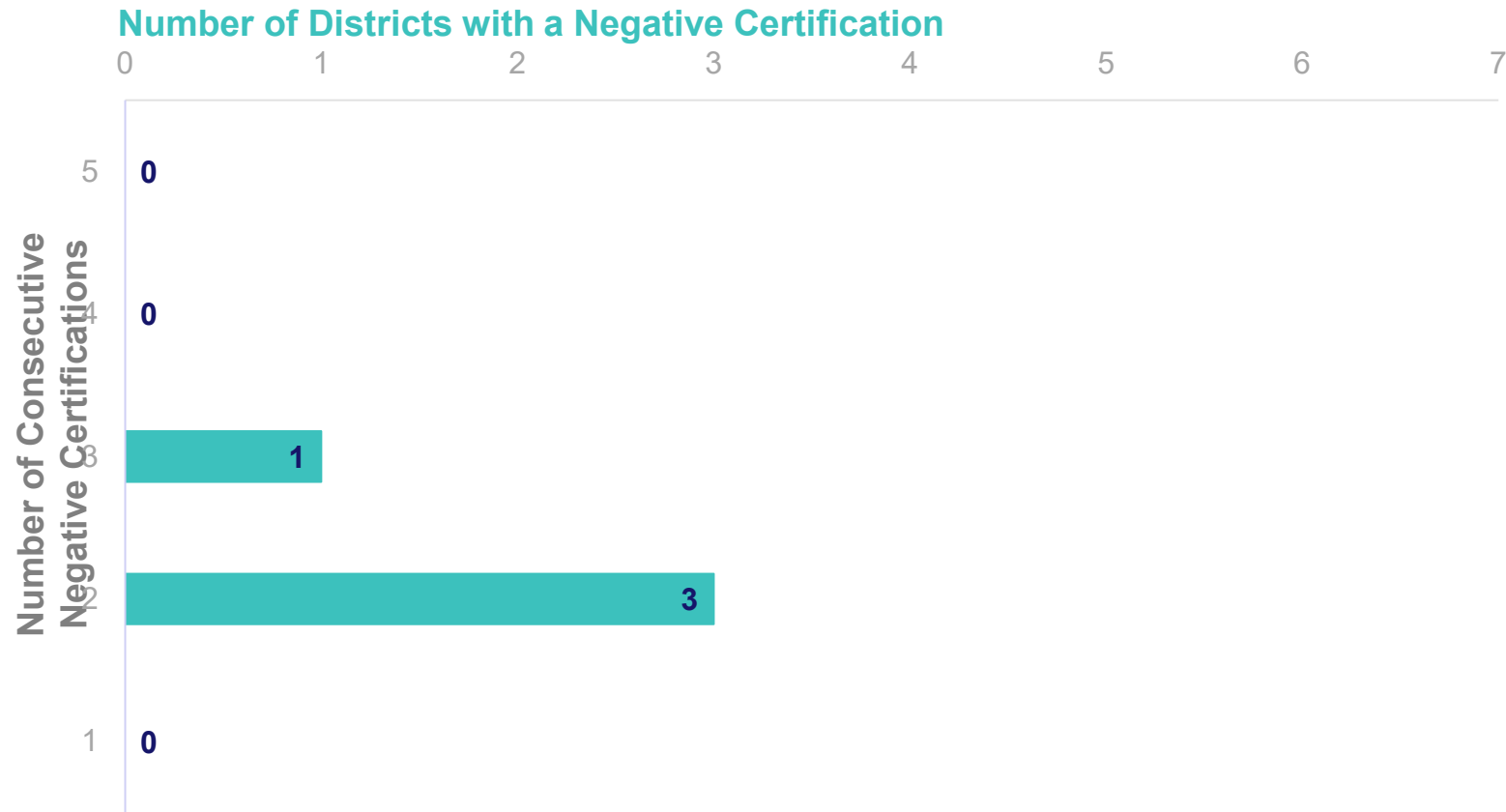

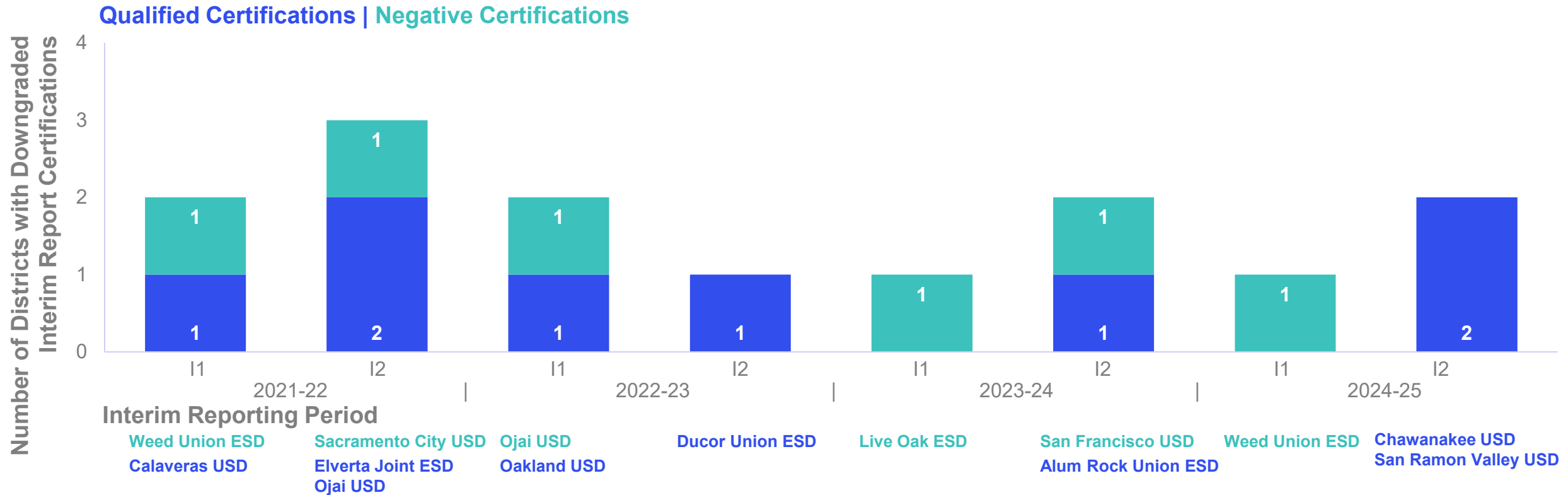

Downgraded Interim Report Certifications

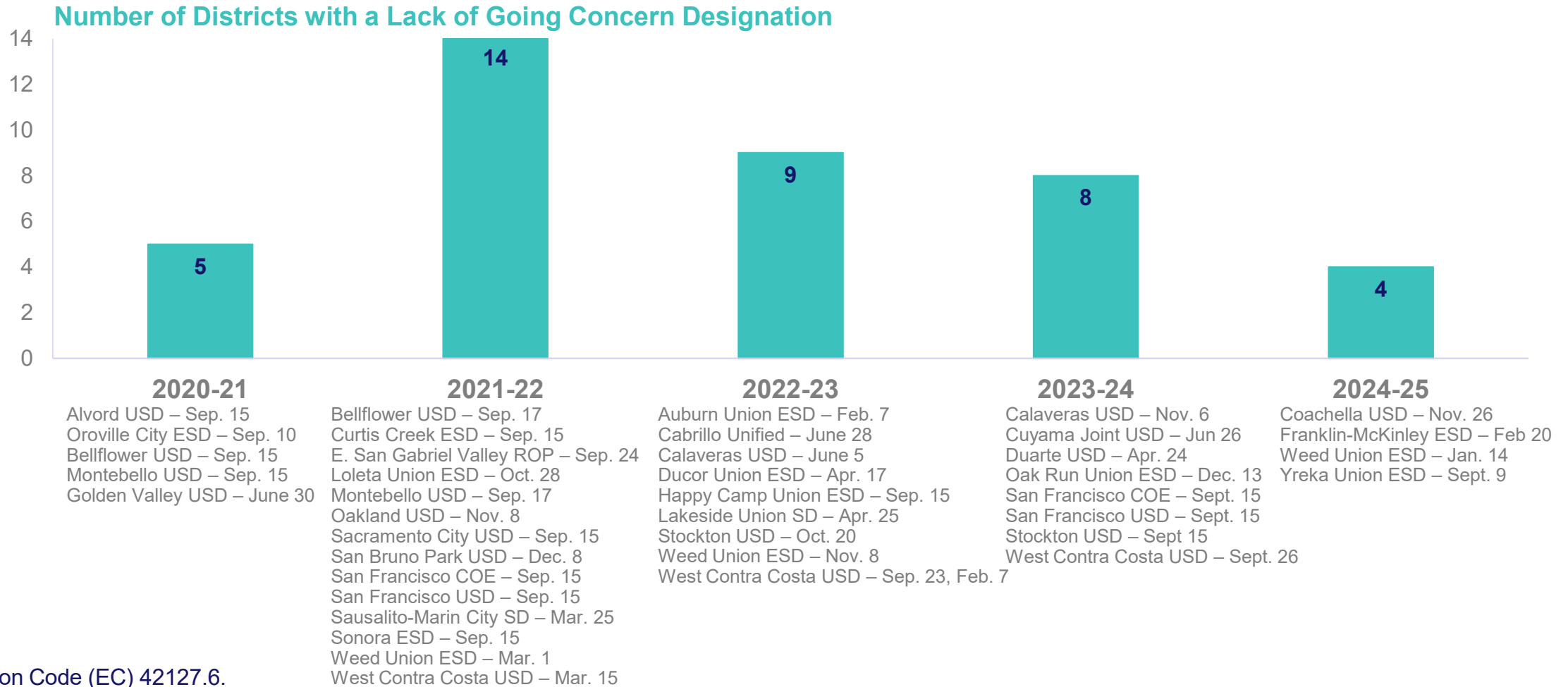
